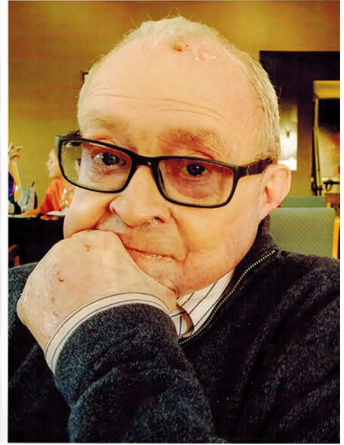


Roast Master — Danny Marona
